

## From the President: Did you Know?

When you pay your membership fees to the Salmon Arm Fish and Game Club (SAFGC), you are not only paying to be a member of our club.

1. Question: Do you know where your membership fees go?

Answer: A portion of the fee goes to the British Columbia Wildlife Federation (BCWF) to pay for your membership in the BCWF and the insurance coverage all members receive when they join.

The following breaks down what each SAFGC member pays and to whom.

Type	Club Dues	Club Retains	Fee to BCWF	BCWF Portion	Capri Insurance
Family	\$170	\$120	\$50	\$38	\$12
Single	\$135	\$100	\$35	\$29	\$6
Senior	\$130	\$100	\$30	\$23.50	\$6

Question: How does the insurance coverage work?

Answer: When you pay SAFGC your membership fees, BCWF's insurance carrier automatically indemnifies you under their group policy. Members benefit from the off-road vehicle coverage they receive on their quads.

Question: Are membership fee increases under our Club's control?

Answer: No. Our club has no control over how BCWF or Capri Insurance sets their rates. They are likely to increase in the future.
