



ARCHERY RANGE RULES

[Bow and Arrow, Cross Bow ONLY: No Firearms]

1. **Safety** First! **Safety** is **Everyone's** responsibility. The first person on the range assumes Firing Line Sentry duties.
2. Communicate with each other and check with shooters before shooting.
3. Declare a **Cease Fire** among all shooters to retrieve arrows.
4. Preparing for a **Cease Fire**, Firing Line Sentry monitors Firing Line or Puts a No Shoot Marker Up:
 - i. **Bows, Arrows** and **Cross Bows**: Uncock Cross Bow; Do not knock Arrows
 - ii. **Leave Bows** and **Cross Bows** at Firing Line
 - iii. Retrieve Arrows; If alone **Put** a **No Shoot Marker Up**
5. **Cross Bows** shall be **Carried Uncocked**; **Load** only **at Firing Line**.
6. Use **Only Field Points**, **No Broad Head** Arrows **Points**, on field butts and animals.
7. **Never Step** in **Front** of the **Firing Line** while archery range is live.
8. **No Cross Firing**; Make sure of your target, **Aim Down Field** and ensure arrow lands safely if you miss.
9. **Never Fire High** into the **Air**.
10. **Reduce Ricochet** Danger:
 - i. Never shoot at the ground; Use target butts and animal targets provided.
 - ii. Ensure **Arrows Strike** the **End Berm** if you miss.
11. A Yellow Ribbon across the **3D Archery Trail** means it is **CLOSED**. Do not walk it.
12. Do not walk the **3D Trail** in **Reverse Direction**; it is **UNSAFE**.
