



The Purposes of the Society:

1. To operate an accessible range facility for our members, guests and the law enforcement community.
2. To support the safe and principled sports of hunting, fishing, archery and shooting by maintaining a quality range and facility for the benefit of our members, law enforcement agencies and our community.
3. To promote ethical harvesting, conservation and enhancement of wildlife, fish and the habitat on which they depend.
4. To provide a broad range of well managed and safe outdoor activities for the enjoyment of our members and guests.
5. To maintain federally certified ranges for the designated shooting disciplines of archery, black powder, long rifle, handgun, trap and shotgun, IPSC, 3-Gun and tactical;
6. To maintain the clubhouse for training and education in the shooting disciplines, and for meetings and social events.
7. To provide the clubhouse for Canadian Firearms Safety Course and British Columbia Wildlife Federation CORE training.
8. To contract with law enforcement agencies and schedule confidential access to the Tactical Range for their members to train.
9. To educate all members about safety and codes of conduct.
10. To manage member safety on the firearms ranges.
11. To organize and sponsor activities for our members and the community.
12. To promote the club and its principles and programs to youth, students and families.
13. To support the aims of the British Columbia Wildlife Federation (BCWF) as an affiliate association.
